Status, Resources & Community Meeting

Del Rio Trail construction is underway and we've created a dedicated construction website—DelRioTrailConstruction.org—to house the most current construction updates. We are doing everything possible to keep construction impacts to a minimum and will keep you updated throughout construction.

While we do our best to plan construction activities, the recent and ongoing storms have slowed some field operations. Project activities currently underway include:

- Tree removals, brush clearing and fence removals to facilitate clearing operations, generally starting from the south end of the project and progressing to the north through the rest of January.
- Obtaining approvals for traffic control plans in anticipation of construction activities at the intersection of all roadway crossings.
- Installing temporary construction entrances made of large, crushed rock. Before re-entering the road, construction vehicles will drive through these temporary entrances to remove dirt and prevent tracking onto roads at major intersections.

You may see construction vehicles or equipment deliveries marked by temporary orange signs and staffed with flaggers to guide them into the project site, as needed. Please be safe and follow flagger directions and signs. We will provide advance notice as we get closer to work requiring traffic control. Currently, there are no detours or lane closures scheduled.
